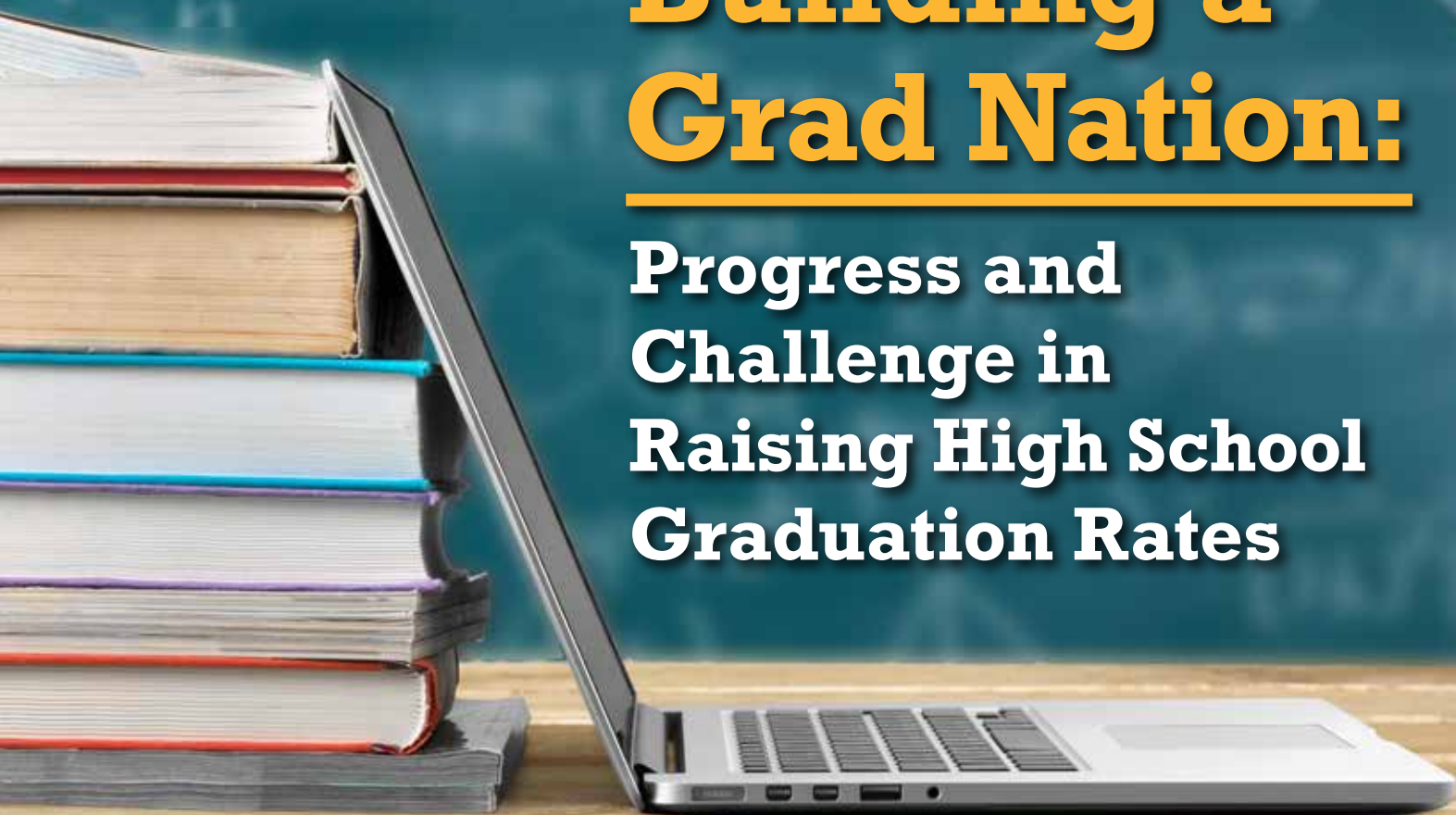

To Reach 90 by 2020, The Nation Must Focus on Equity for All

At 83.2 percent, the national graduation rate is at an all-time high. Most notably, low-income students made up nearly half of the class of 2015. However, to reach the GradNation goal of 90 percent by 2020, the nation must double its pace of progress and focus on the deep disparities that remain for specific subgroups. While progress continues, skepticism in the media has cast doubt on the validity of gains in graduation rates.

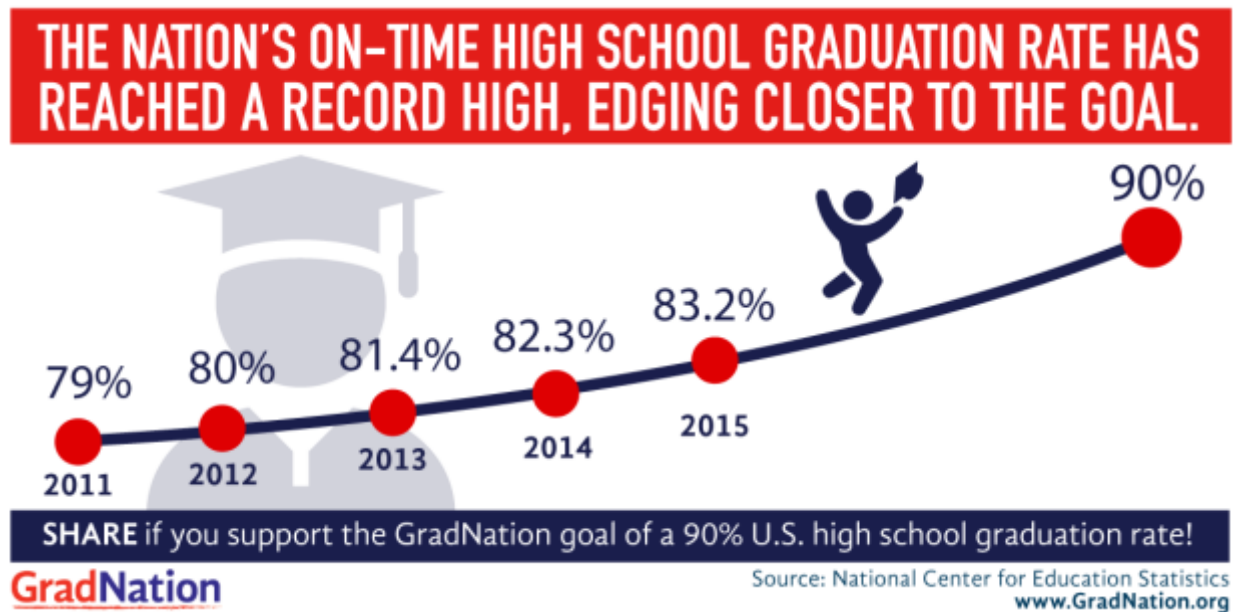
